

Covid Comp Rules

The competition is intended to be a fun ongoing weekly run competition available to all Swindon League members either shot at team ranges or at home. General rules are as Swindon League rules with the following variations:

Range: A home range may be 6yd if 7yd is not practical

Target Card: Preferably League cards but use of home printed targets on paper using the pdf available on the Swindon177 website may be used.

Rules specific to the comp

1. One qualifying score per week may be submitted by any Swindon League member.
2. Clubs submitting a number of entries in one email may submit checked scores with no supporting card, but cards must be retained in case of draws. **Possibles to be outward marked.** Individuals submitting their own results must send a clear photo of the dated and signed card.
3. Scores to be emailed to postal@swindon177.co.uk
4. Cards may be shot at any time during "a week" and the results must be emailed by the end of the week (assessed by the received email date and time stamp).
5. The week starts each Wednesday at 00:01hrs and finishes the following Tuesday at 23:59hrs.
6. The first score received per individual per week will be counted as the scoring card.
7. When first entering the comp the first submitted score will not accrue any "win" points. Any member can enter the comp at any time after the start date.
8. Any entrant who does not shoot for 3 consecutive weeks will be dropped from the results table and will have to restart from scratch if they wish to rejoin.

Format of comp

Having shot one "entry card" the [results table](#) will be ranked in order of average placing shooters in closely matched average "Classes" of 3.

In the following round the 3 shooters per Class are competing for first place within their Class of three and the winner of each Class will be awarded 1 point. If the highest score in a group is achieved by two or more they will each be awarded one half point. Possibles will be ranked by outward marks.

The table will then be re-sorted in order of the running average to assign Classes for the following week.

If there is one shooter alone in the bottom Class they will compete in the Class above. If there are two shooters in the bottom Class they will compete against each other.

Overall winner of the comp will be the person with the most "win" points at the end of the comp.

Start date: Wed 14 Oct 2020

Finish date: the Tuesday immediately preceding resumption of regular League matches.
