SUMMER COMPETITION RULES

1. Only flat-headed pellets of 4.5mm (1.77) Calibre are to be used.
2. The range shall be 6.4M (21 Feet) to the target. Height to centre of paper card target 1.53m (5') approx. *This competition is for free standing air rifle shooting only.*
3. One shot per diagram, more will result in the lowest scores counting. If a shot hits the target but fails to cut a diagram then you can re-fire on the same diagram without penalty. *A Shot recorded that does not cut the paper target in a general manner as others received, will be disallowed. (Ten points deducted)*
4. TEAM EVENT FORMAT Teams will be entered into divisions made up of teams of similar ability. A team handicap allowance will be introduced if the team average difference is substantial. Seven shots to count, the top two diagrams either side of the identification sticker are for sighting only. The two highest scores from a team of three will count as the round score. Round winners will be awarded two points or one point for a draw.
5. INDIVIDUAL EVENT FORMAT. Competitors will be entered into divisions made up of individuals of similar ability. A handicap allowance will be introduced if the individual's average difference is substantial. Ten shots to count. The highest score for each round will be awarded maximum points and the lowest scorer one point at least. Ties will be separated by the highest number of tens, nines, eight's etc. and if necessary the highest number of inner tens.
6. Points will not be awarded if cards are not returned. A minimum of 75% of rounds must be submitted to avoid disqualification.
7. Rounds may be fired in advance but in the correct order.
8. Shot cards must be signed by the competitor, witnessed with the date and returned to the Summer Competition Scorer no later than two days after the last date of shooting for each round.
9. The witness must be satisfied that the cards they are witnessing are shot in accordance with the above rules.
10. Entries will not be accepted unless the competition fees and official individual *league* average statistics are included. For new shooters three trial card targets may be included with your entry. (Contact summer league sec.) Cheques made Payable to Newport & District Air Rifle League.
11. At the end of season, a Chairman's Shoot will be classed to four levels based of averages from the current seasons scores. Top four scorers in each class, to shoot again in the final on the same day. Each class finalist with the highest aggregate score will be the class winner. All members eligible for this event providing a minimum three rounds scores have been returned. *This is subject to the number of entries received.*
12. All decisions made by the League Management Committee will be final.
